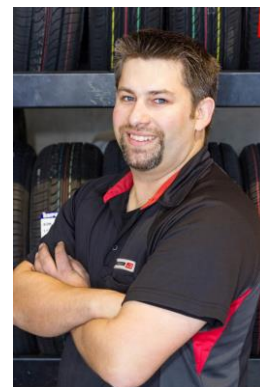
Andrew has been working on a new motor for his old 1966 Dodge Coronet – most weekends he's up in his shed with his mate Ken working on the 440!

Simmo's Tyre Tips

This time I want to talk about your spare tyre and the equipment you should have in your boot to be able to change it if needed. You should check the air pressure in your spare tyre at the same time as you check your other 4 tyres (but we can do that for you if you bring your car in to us). Having 2 flat tyres is really uncool! Depending on your vehicle you should have a certain amount of equipment stowed in your boot. There should be:

- A wheel brace
- A jack
- Jack handle
- Possibly a small block of wood to chock the wheels
- For 4WDs, most vans and people movers - make sure you know where the handle is to get the spare tyre out from underneath. You need to know where the tools are to remove that tyre.

If your vehicle is fitted with lock nuts, make sure you know where the key is! We have a number of vehicles that come in and the owner doesn't know that they actually have lock nuts, and no idea where the key is! That's a real problem if they get a flat tyre and have no way of being able to get that wheel off.

If you're not sure whether you have everything you need, call in to see us and we will check for you.

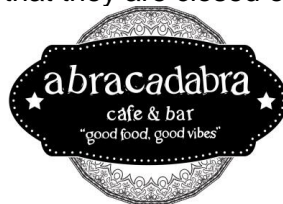
Not only, but also...

Julie's Recipe

Here's another great recipe from Julie, one of our long time customers. Yummy!

Simple Seafood Tapas

185g tin crabmeat or any other fish (ie prawns/scallops etc)
Drizzle with 1 tbsp lemon juice

In a blender or food processor, mix:
125g cream cheese
2 tbsp chopped parsley
2 tbsp mayonnaise
1 chopped spring onion
1 clove garlic (minced)
2 dashes tabasco or chilli sauce
2 tsp Worcester sauce

Fold in the seafood, check the flavour.
Serve either at room temperature with crackers, or make crostini and top with the seafood mix, then bake at 200 deg Celsius for 5 minutes.
Serve them warm and garnish with slivers of chilli or red onion.
