## Simmo's Tyre Tips

Are you ready for the holiday season?

Just a refresher as we have covered this before - but are your vehicles ready for the holidays? And not just the car or 4wd but boat trailers, caravans, garden trailers etc.

These other vehicles demand special attention as they sit around [usually outside] for the bulk of the year, then we all expect them to perform at their best for the trips away.

Tyres that have been on trailers, caravans etc tend to be a lot older than we remember as they sit around so long and don't seem to wear out. The danger though is that the tyre has degraded/perished sitting in the sun over the years and can unexpectedly blow out on the family holiday, causing huge drama. Our advice is get them checked out before you go. Just call in and we can check for age and condition [we can tell by serial numbers how old the tyres are] and make sure your holiday is not interrupted by roadside drama.

If you're checking your own tyres, look for cracking in the sidewalls and in the tread valleys which indicate perished, degraded rubber.

### Raspberry Syrup:

#### Ingredients:

- 2cups raspberries (fresh or frozen)
- ½ cup water
- ½ cup sugar
- 1 tbsp vanilla extract

## Method:

Combine in a saucepan, boil, and continue stirring until the sugar is dissolved and it's a bit thicker, strain seeds and refrigerate syrup. Will keep for a few weeks in the fridge.

### For the spritzer:

## Ingredients and bits and bobs

- You'll need a large glass drinks dispenser that can hold around 5L
- Ice
- 3L of Soda water
- 1.5 L of Lemonade
- ½ cup lemon juice
- Raspberry Syrup
- Fresh Mint Leaves (Around a good handful)
- Lemon wedges
- Lime Wedges

### Method:

- Fill the drinks dispenser about a quarter of the way with ice.
- 2. Put 1.5L of soda water in first
- 3. Then add your raspberry syrup and lemon juice
- Then add the mint leaves (clapped between your cupped hands to release flavour), lemon and lime wedges (squeezed slightly)
- 5. Then add the remaining soda water and lemonade.

N.B. This recipe is designed to be refreshing not sickly sweet, if you want it to be sweeter replace 1.5L of the soda water with lemonade.
